



Class of 2015 - IB Results and University Acceptance

Following the release of the results of the IB Diploma Programme in May 2015, we are very pleased to announce the achievements of DCB Class of 2015.

Dulwich College Beijing's (DCB) IB average score was 38.2 points, far surpassing the world average of 29.9 points.

A remarkable 35% of our students achieved scores of 40+ points, with five students – Charles Chiu, JinJu Choi, Brian Hwang, Michelle Lim and Kay Liang – achieving perfect scores of 45. Only about 160 students worldwide out of over 140,000 candidates achieved this result.

Over 85%* of our 2015 graduates have accepted places in the top 50 universities in the world** in Art & Design, Business & Management Studies, Communications & Media Studies, Economics, Engineering, History, Hospitality Management, Medicine, Politics and International Relations.
